Regulation of Smith Island

Use of dock space

- Only Family and Seniors Members have overnight privileges.
- · Associate members are entitled to day use.
- The use is on a first come basis.
- Overnights during weekends should not be consecutive through July and August, but can be extended during the week or out of season. (I.e. don't combo Friday night/ Saturday or Saturday / Sunday during these two months.)
- Family and senior members who stay overnight during the weekends of July and August, automatically take the role of "Smith Island Dock Master". In this role, they are responsible for the boaters who come in need of dock space. If an empty space is not available the "Dock Master" will welcome the incoming boat and either release a slip or make sure that the rafting provisions are undertaken. Rafting boats is reasonable and encouraged when necessary. When rafting use the large fixed docks that have been provided for this purpose.
- Remember, "no Member is diverted from Smith Island".
- Quiet hours are from 23:00 through 7 in the morning.
- No excessive noise.
- No visiting boats or reciprocals can use the facilities at Smith Island.
- Sailing school will be limited to a daily use with prior approval and instructors present.
- BYC activity log to be signed at each visit. Log book is in the Cook House.
- No use of generators, except on boats with inboard mounted units.

Use of island facilities

- Animals must be "leashed", while on the waterfront or on the Island property. Pooper shovel law in force.
- · No tents or allowed on the island.
- Please leave kitchen, washroom, BBQ's, boathouse, clean.
- The removal of garbage is every Member's responsibility.
- Members must comply with the City of Brockville regulations.
- The last person to leave the island is responsible for tuning off all the lights and locking the buildings.
- Open fires are limited to the designated fire zones.
- No cutting of trees.
- Respect your fellow boaters, strong language will not be tolerated.
- Problems / comments should be recorded and reported to the Director of Smith Island. (See blue book)

THERE IS NO CUSTODIAL SERVICE ON THE ISLAND, MEMBERS WHO USE THE FACILITIES ARE EXPECTED TO HELP IN THE MAINTENANCE AND KEEP THE FACILITIES TIDY.
